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Office of Health Transformation Announces Staff Changes

Columbus – Greg Moody, Director of the Governor's Office of Health Transformation (OHT), today announced that Aaron Crooks will join the OHT team as Director of Government Affairs and Communications. Before joining OHT, Aaron served as Director of Government Relations for the OhioHealth hospital system. He previously held the position of legislative liaison at the Ohio Department of Medicaid after working almost a decade in the Ohio Senate.

"I'm thrilled Aaron has agreed to return to state service," Moody said. "His experience fits perfectly with Governor Kasich's priority to engage public and private sector partners to design and implement new health care delivery payment systems that reward the value of health care services, not the volume of those services."

Governor John R. Kasich created OHT in 2011 to modernize Medicaid, streamline health and human services, and improve overall health system performance. In 2014, OHT is partnering with Ohio's largest commercial health insurance plans to implement new health care payment models that increase access to patient-centered primary care and reward health care providers that coordinate episodes of care.
